I am writing to inform you that following receipt of an opposition to the above trade mark, it is necessary to issue this formal provisional refusal letter. This provisional refusal covers all of the goods and services of the International Registration.

If both parties to this dispute wish to negotiate and want to enter a 'cooling off period' then the time for filing the TM8 can be extended for a further seven months by the filing the form TM9c 'Request for a cooling off period, which is available at ipo.gov.uk/tmforms

The TM8 should be received on or before the date requested above unless a cooling off period is entered into by the parties.

The holder of the International Registration must provide us with an address for correspondence in the United Kingdom, another EEA state or the Channel



STATEMENT OF GROUNDS

- Biswanath Hosiery Mills Ltd is an Indian company of 39 Kalikrishna Tagore Street, 5th Floor, Calcutta 700007, India, (hereinafter referred to as "the Opponents").
- 2. The Opponents request the refusal of the mark applied for on the basis of Sections 5(1), 5(2)(a) and 5(2)(b) of the Act. The reasons for this request are set out below.
- 3. The mark applied for is identical to the Opponent's earlier registered UK trade mark. In the alternative it is a similar mark. On a visual basis, the Applicants' mark is identical, or similar to the Opponent's mark, in that they both share the element LUX. Orally, the Applicants' mark is identical, due to the shared word LUX. Conceptually, they are identical.
- 4. The Applicants' mark includes goods namely clothing, knitwear (clothing) that are identical to the goods in the Opponent's registered mark. In the alternative, it includes similar goods to men's undergarments, in their being sold through the same trade channels, with the same consumers, for the same, or similar purpose, with the same or similar nature, and with similar manufacturers. In the circumstances, the mark applied for is identical, for identical goods, or an identical, or similar mark for similar and identical goods and given the similarities between the Applicants' mark and the Opponent's mark and the overlap in the goods, there is a risk of confusion arising.
- The Opponents request the refusal of the application for the opposed goods, and an award of costs.
