



## X. (Title and date of the applicable national law)

### Extract from the Trade Mark Law Version of 19/10/2013, Section 96 updated

#### *Absolute obstacles to protection*

8. - (1) Signs eligible for protection as a trade mark within the meaning of section 3 which cannot be depicted graphically shall be excluded from registration.

(2) The following trade marks shall be excluded from registration

1. those which are devoid of any distinctive character for the goods or services,
2. which consist exclusively of signs or indications which may serve, in the course of trade, to designate the nature, quality, quantity, intended purpose, value, geographical origin or the time of production of the goods or of rendering of the services or to designate other characteristics of the goods or services,
3. which consist exclusively of signs or indications which have become customary in the current usage or in the bona fide and established practices of the trade to designate the goods or services,
4. which are of such a nature to mislead the public, in particular with regard to the nature, the quality or the geographical origin of the goods or services,
5. which are contrary to public policy or to accepted principles of morality,
6. which contain state coats of arms, state flags or other sovereign state symbols or coats of arms of a domestic locality or of a domestic municipal or other local authority association,
7. which contain official certification marks or hallmarks which are excluded from registration as a trade mark in accordance with a notice made by the Federal Ministry of Justice in the Federal Law Gazette (BGBl.),
8. which contain coats of arms, flags or other symbols, seals or designations of international intergovernmental organisations which are excluded from registration as a trade mark in accordance with a notice made by the Federal Ministry of Justice in the Federal Law Gazette,
9. the use of which can evidently be prohibited in the public interest in accordance with other provisions, or
10. which have been applied for in bad faith.

(3) Subs. 2 Nos. 1, 2 and 3 shall not apply if, prior to the point in time of the decision on registration, the trade mark has become established in the trade circles involved as a result of its use for the goods or services for which the application was filed.

(4) Subs. 2 Nos. 6, 7 and 8 shall also be applied if the trade mark contains the imitation of a sign listed there. Subs. 2 Nos. 6, 7 and 8 shall not be applied if the applicant is empowered to include in the trade mark one of the signs listed therein, even if it can be confused with one of the other signs listed therein. Subs. 2 No. 7 shall furthermore not be applied if the goods or services for which the trade mark application was filed are neither identical with nor similar to those for which the certification mark or hallmark has been introduced. Subs. 2 No. 8 shall further not be applied if the trade mark applied for is not suitable to create among the public the incorrect impression of a connection with the international intergovernmental organisation.

#### *Trade marks that have been filed or registered as relative obstacles to protection*

9. - (1) The Registration of a trade mark may be cancelled

1. if it is identical to a trade mark applied for or registered which has older seniority and the goods or services for which it was registered are identical with the goods or services for which the trade mark with older seniority was filed or registered,
2. if the likelihood of confusion exists, including the likelihood of association between the trade marks, for the public because of its identity with or similarity to a trade mark applied for or registered with older seniority and owing to the

identity or similarity of the goods or services covered by both trade marks, or

3. if it is identical with or similar to a trade mark applied for or registered with older seniority and has been registered for goods or services which are not similar to those for which the trade mark with older seniority has been filed or registered, if the trade mark with older seniority is a trade mark which has a reputation in this country and the use of the registered trade mark would without due cause take unfair advantage of, or be detrimental to, the distinctive character or the repute of the trade mark which has a reputation.

(2) Applications for trade marks shall only constitute an ground for refusal within the meaning of subs. 1 if they are registered.

#### *Opposition*

42. - (1) Within a three-month period after the date of the publication of the registration of the trade mark in accordance with section 41, the proprietor of a trade mark or of a commercial designation with older seniority may lodge an opposition against the registration of the trade mark.

(2) The opposition may only invoke that the trade mark may be cancelled

1. because of a trade mark applied for or registered with older seniority in accordance with section 9,
2. because of a well-known mark with older seniority in accordance with section 10 in conjunction with section 9,
3. because of its registration for an agent or representative of the trade mark proprietor in accordance with section 11, or
4. because of a trade mark not registered with older seniority in accordance with section 4 No. 2 or of a commercial designation with older seniority in accordance with section 5 in conjunction with section 12.

(3) (repealed)

#### *Objection of insufficient use, decision on the opposition*

43. - (1) If the opposition has been lodged by the proprietor of a registered trade mark with older seniority, he/she shall, if the other party disputes the use of the trade mark, make a plausible case that he/she, within the last five years prior to the publication of the registration of the trade mark which is targeted by the opposition, has been used in accordance with section 26 insofar as it has been registered for at least five years at this point in time. If the period of five years of non-use ends after the publication of the registration, the opponent, if the other party disputes the use, must make a plausible case that the trade mark has been used in accordance with section 26 within the past five years prior to the decision on the opposition. Only those goods or services shall be taken into consideration in the decision with respect to which a plausible case has been made for use.

(2) If the examination of the opposition reveals that the trade mark is to be cancelled for all or part of the goods or services in respect of which it is registered, the registration shall be cancelled in full or in part. If the registration of the trade mark cannot be cancelled, the opposition shall be refused.

(3) If the registered trade mark is to be cancelled because of one or several trade marks with older seniority, the proceedings on further objections may be suspended until a decision has been handed down with legal force on the registration of the trade mark.

(4) Section 52 subs. 2 and 3 shall be applied *mutatis mutandis* in the event of cancellation in accordance with subs. 2.

#### *Domestic representative*

96. - (1) Any person who has neither their residence nor principal place of business nor an establishment in Germany may participate in the proceedings before the German Patent and Trade Mark Office or the Federal

Patent Court which are regulated under this Act and assert the rights deriving from a trade mark only if he has appointed as his representative a lawyer or patent attorney who is authorised and empowered to represent him in proceedings before the German Patent and Trade Mark Office, before the Federal Patent Court and in civil litigation affecting this trade mark, as well as to file motions for criminal prosecution.

(2) The place where a representative appointed pursuant to subsection (1) has his commercial premises shall be deemed, within the meaning of section 23 of the Code of Civil Procedure, to be the place where the asset is located; if there are no such commercial premises, the place where the representative is residing in Germany shall be decisive or, if there is no such place, the place where the German Patent and Trade Mark Office has its seat.

(3) The legal termination of the appointment of a representative in accordance with subsection (1) shall not become effective until the German Patent and Trade Mark Office or the Federal Patent Court has been informed of both the termination of this appointment and the appointment of another representative.

#### *Application of the provisions of this Act; language*

107. (1) The provisions of this Act shall be applied *mutatis mutandis* to the international registration of trade marks in accordance with the Madrid Agreement Concerning the International Registration of Marks (Madrid Agreement on Marks) carried out through the intermediary of the Patent Office or whose protection covers the territory of the Federal Republic of Germany unless provided otherwise in this Chapter or in the Madrid Agreement on Marks.

(2) All and any applications, as well as other communications in the proceedings for international registration and the list of goods and services, shall be submitted in either French or English, at the choice of the applicant.

#### *Opposition*

114. - (1) The publication of the registration (section 41) for internationally-registered trade marks shall be substituted by publication in the Information Notice published by the International Bureau of the World Intellectual Property Organisation.

(2) The time limit to lodge the opposition (section 42 subs. 1) against the granting of protection for internationally-registered trade marks shall commence on the first day of the month following the month stated as the issue month of the edition of the Information Notice containing the publication of the internationally-registered trade mark.


(3) Refusal of protection shall take the place of the cancellation of the registration (section 43 subs. 2).

#### **Extract from the Trade Mark Ordinance version of 11 May 2004**

##### *Section 46 Refusal of Protection*

(1) Where protection is, in full or in part, refused to an international registration the protection of which has been extended to the territory of the Federal Republic of Germany under Article 3ter of the Madrid Agreement or under Article 3ter of the Protocol Relating to the Madrid Agreement, and where this refusal is communicated to the International Bureau of the World Intellectual Property Organization to be transmitted to the proprietor of the international registration, the time limit for appointing a representative in Germany shall, to avoid final refusal, be fixed to four months from the date on which notification of refusal was dispatched by the International Bureau of the World Intellectual Property Organization.

(2) Where the refusal of protection has become final because the proprietor of the international registration has failed to appoint a representative in Germany, a special motion (*Erinnerung*) or an appeal from the refusal shall be filed with the German Patent and Trade Mark Office within one further month after the time limit under subsection (1). Instructions about the proprietor's right to appeal shall be attached to the refusal. Section 61(2) of the Trade Mark Act shall apply *mutatis mutandis*.

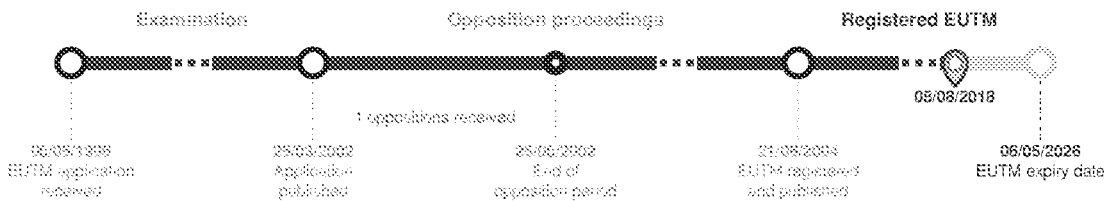

- Industrial oils and greases, lubricants, dust-absorbing, wetting and binding compositions, solid, liquid and gaseous fuels (including motor spirit); illuminants, candles and wicks (lighting), fire lighters, briquettes (fuel), gas for lighting, firewood, charcoal, grease for arms, grease for shoes, textile and clothing oils.
- Dressings, first aid products and dietetic products.
- Common metals and their alloys, metal building materials, transportable buildings of metal, materials of metal for railway tracks, non-electric cables and wires of common metal, ironmongery (non-electric); small items of metal hardware,

**11** Apparatus for lighting, heating, steam generating, cooking, refrigerating, drying, ventilating, water supply and sanitary purposes, extractor hoods, air cooling devices, air conditioning installations for vehicles, cold stores, electric pressure cookers, electric bottle warmers, baths, barbecues, cookers, freezers, hairdryers, refrigerators, ornamental fountains, gas lighters, toasters, ice-making equipment, electric lights, sauna installations, electric coffee makers, solar panels, solariums, shower cubicles, electric lightbulbs, electric Christmas tree lights, headlights and lamps for vehicles, filters for drinking water.

**12** Vehicles, apparatus for locomotion by land, air or water, bicycles, bicycle stabilizers, inner tubes for tyres, tyres, pumps, saddles, spokes, tubeless bicycle tyres, mirrors, bells, chains, pedals, rims, bicycle brakes, mud guards, puncture repair kits, canoes, caravans, seat belts for vehicles, child security seats for vehicles, prams, vehicle covers, vehicle seat covers, baggage racks, bicycle racks, ski racks for cars, push chairs, parachutes, skilifts, windscreens, airships, anti-theft devices for vehicles, oars, boats, boat hooks, control devices for boats, boat propellers, hand trucks, wheelbarrows, anti-skid chains, golf trolleys, wheelchairs.

**13** Fire arms, ammunition and projectiles, explosives, fireworks, air pistols, rifles, hunting guns, revolvers, teargas weapons for protection, bandoleers for arms, cartridge belts, harpoon guns, shooting trestles, dynamite, fog signals, ballistic missiles.

**14** Precious metals and their alloys other than for dental purposes; jewellery, watches, horological and chronometric instruments, cuff links, tie pins, fancy keyrings, watch straps, sundials.

**15** Musical instruments, constituent parts of musical instruments.

**16** Paper, cardboard (untreated, semi-finished or for stationery), printed matter except that relating to decathlon events, bookbinding material, photographs except those relating to decathlon events, stationery, adhesives for stationery or household purposes, artists' materials, paintbrushes, typewriters and office requisites (except furniture), instructional and teaching material (except apparatus) except that relating to decathlon events, bags and sheets of paper or plastics, for packaging; playing cards, printers' type, printing blocks, staples for offices, drawing pins, pencil sharpeners, correcting fluids, paper cutters, drawing sets, pencils, pencil lead holders, rubber erasers, envelopes, folders, albums except those relating to decathlon events, almanacs except those relating to decathlon events, pamphlets except those relating to decathlon events, exercise books, calendars, posters except those relating to decathlon events, maps, tear off calendars, printed timetables, newspapers except those relating to decathlon events, typewriters, spools for inking ribbons, sealing wax, mailing machines, stapling presses, tape dispensers, shredders for paper, napkins of paper for removing make-up, disposable nappies of paper or of cellulose, coffee filters of paper, transfers (decalcomanias), wrapping paper, signboards of paper or cardboard, terrestrial globes, toilet paper, table linen of paper, hand towels of paper, mats for beer glasses, canvases for painting, postcards except those relating to decathlon events, compasses for drawing.

**17** Rubber, gutta-percha, gum, asbestos, mica; semi-finished products of plastic, flexible tubes not of metal, floating anti-pollution barriers, garden hoses, sealing rings, buttons of rubber, glass wool for insulation purposes, insulating gloves, fibres of plastic except textiles, horseshoes not of metal.

**18** Leather and imitations of leather, articles of leather or imitation leather (except for cases adapted to the products they are designed to hold, gloves and belts), animal skins, trunks and suitcases, umbrellas, parasols and canes, whips and saddlery, harnesses, rucksacks and alpine walking sticks, camping, beach, travel, school and food bags, travelling sets, animal collars, animal vests, muzzles, saddles, whips, saddle attachments, horse covers, saddle covers, headstalls for horses, feeding bags, harnesses, knee bandages for horses, walking stick seats, school satchels, wallets, game bags, clothing covers (travel), purses, wallets, key holders (leather), straps for skates, slings for carrying children, wheeled shopping bags.

**19** Building materials (non-metallic); non-metallic rigid pipes for building; asphalt, pitch and bitumen; non-metallic transportable buildings; monuments, not of metal; worked timber, construction and panelling timber, swimming pools (constructions not of metal), bird baths (constructions not of metal), cabanas not of metal, luminous paving, lighting; perches, diving boards, not of metal.

**20** Furniture, mirrors,; frames (except for building construction), art works or ornaments of wood, cork, reed, cane, wicker, horn, bone, ivory, whalebone, shell, amber, mother-of-pearl, meerschaum and substitutes of all these materials, or of plastics,; dog kennels, beehives, honeycomb, advertising boards, fixed towel dispensers, not of metal, gun racks, playpens, cradles, sleeping bags for camping, cushions, clothes pegs, mannequins, mattresses, deckchairs, food decorations of plastic, stuffed animals, shells, office furniture; tables, offices, armchairs, chairs, stands for computers and printers, facsimile machines, photocopiers, cupboards, bottle corks.

**21** Household or kitchen utensils and containers, non-electric (not of precious metal or coated therewith), combs and sponges, brushes (except paint brushes), brush-makina materials, articles for cleaning purposes, steelwool, unworked or semi-worked glass (except glass used in building), tableware, not of precious metal, glassware, porcelain and earthenware, aerosol dispensers, heat-insulated containers for food and drink, drinking flasks, mess-tins, portable coolers, non-electric, goblets, not of precious metal, grills, kitchen utensils, fitted picnic baskets (tableware), litter trays, combs for animals, watering implements, household gloves, carpet sweepers, brooms, chamois leathers for cleaning purposes, shaving brushes, toothbrushes, toothpicks, corkscrews, bottle openers, metal boxes for dispensing paper towels, soap dispensers, household sponges, extendable clothes lines, dustbins, insect traps, trouser presses, crumb trays, cages for pets, bird cages, shoe horns, shoe stretchers, shoe trees, insect traps.

**22** Cords (not of rubber or for rackets and musical instruments), strings, nets, tents, awnings (except safety awnings and pushchair covers), sails, sacks and bags of textile for wrapping, padding and stuffing materials (except of rubber and plastic), raw fibrous textile materials, fishing nets, hammocks, rope ladders.

**23** Threads of elastic or plastic for textile use, cotton thread and yarn, sewing threads, woollen thread and yarn.

**24** Textiles and textile goods, bed and table covers, adhesive fabrics for application by heat, upholstery fabrics, bath linen (except clothing), billiard cloths, oilcloth (table cloths), sleeping bags (sheeting), tissues of textile for removing make-up, mosquito nets, labels of cloth, canvas for tapestry or embroidery, flags, blinds of textile.

**25** Clothing, sports clothing except diving suits, shoes (except orthopaedic shoes), headgear, swimming trunks, caps, dressing gowns, sweaters, socks, football boots, beach shoes, ski boots, sports shoes, shirts, water ski suits, underwear, babies' napkins of textile, cyclists' clothing, soles for footwear, gloves, studs for football boots, non-slipping devices for shoes, tips for footwear, suspenders, belts, ties.

**26** Lace and embroidery, ribbons and braid, buttons, hooks and eyes, pins and needles, artificial flowers, small pins, fastenings for clothing, ornamental badges, hair bands and nets, hair pins, hair-slides, hair, false hair, fancy goods, zippers, shoe laces, buttons, snap fasteners.

**27** Carpets, rugs, mats and matting, linoleum and other floor covering (except for tile floorings and floor paints), gymnastic mats, wall hangings not of textile, car mats, bath mats, artificial lawns.

**28** Games and playthings, gymnastic and sporting articles (except clothing, mats and shoes) except those relating to decathlon events and except discuses for sports, javelins, shots and discuses for throwing and poles; Decorations for Christmas trees, building blocks (playthings), hang gliders, paragliders, kites, artificial fishing bait, fishing rods, reels for fishing rods, landing nets for anglers, harpoon guns (sporting articles), hooks, fishing line, decoys for hunting or fishing, items for shooting, targets, clay pigeon traps, clay pigeons, fencing weapons, foils, fencing masks, discuses for sport, darts, base-ball gloves, boxing gloves, protective clothing (sports articles), machines for physical exercise and appliances for gymnastics, exercisers (expanders), exercise bicycles, exercise benches, abdominal exercising equipment, trampolines, running tracks, oars, billiard cues, billiard tables, billiard balls, golf clubs, golf balls, guts and cords for rackets, tennis rackets, badminton rackets, squash rackets, skis, ski bindings, water skis, dumb-bells, skittles, swimming webs, ice skates, roller skates, skateboards, sailboards, surfboards, masts, booms, table football, table tennis tables, tennis nets, table tennis bats, table tennis balls, slides, shuttlecocks (games), conjuring apparatus, model vehicles, toy masks, toys for pets, swings, Christmas crackers, toy masks.

**29** Meat, fish, poultry and game, meat extracts, preserved, dried and cooked fruits and vegetables; jellies, jams, fruit sauces, eggs, milk and milk products, edible oils and fats, preparations for making bouillon, powdered eggs, chip potatoes, proteins for human consumption, milk beverages.

**30** Coffee, tea, cocoa, sugar, rice, tapioca, sago, artificial coffee, flour and preparations made from cereals, bread, pastry and confectionery, edible ices, honey, treacle, yeast, baking powder, salt, mustard, vinegar, sauces (condiments), spices, ice for refreshments, almond paste, coffee, tea, cocoa and chocolate based drinks.

**31** Agricultural, horticultural and forestry products (non-prepared and non-transformed), grains (seeds), live animals, fresh fruits and vegetables, plant seeds, plants and natural leaves, foodstuffs for animals, malt, pet food, fishing bait (live).

**32** Beers, mineral and aerated waters and other non-alcoholic drinks, fruit drinks and fruit juices, syrups and other preparations for making beverages (except coffee, tea or cocoa based drinks, milk beverages).

**33** Alcoholic beverages (except beers), peppermint liqueurs, alcoholic essences, aperitifs, ciders, cocktails, digesters, spirits, wines.

**34** Tobacco; matches; smokers' articles; cigarette papers, cigarette holders, ashtrays, lighters, pipes; cigar cases and boxes, not of precious metal; tobacco goods, smokers' articles, not of precious metal.

**35** Advertising except that relating to decathlon events; business management except that relating to decathlon events; business administration except that relating to decathlon events; office functions; newspaper subscription services for others; business management, business administration, business information; import-export agencies, commercial information agencies, cost price analysis, employment agencies; publicity columns preparation except that relating to decathlon events, shop window dressing, demonstration of goods, marketing studies, organisation of exhibitions for commercial or advertising purposes, computerized file management, rental of advertising space, marketing research, opinion polling, television advertising except that relating to decathlon events, public relations except those relating to decathlon events, document reproduction.

**36** Insurance, financial affairs, monetary affairs, real estate affairs, accident insurance, factoring, banking services, credit card services, currency exchange, issuing of travellers' cheques, charitable fund raising, real estate management, apartment house management, organisation of lotteries.

**37** Building construction and repair, installation services, vermin extermination other than for agriculture, installation and repair of lifts, vehicle repair, laundering, quarrying services, shoe repairs, service stations, factory construction, vehicle maintenance, burglar alarm installation and repair.

**38** Telecommunications, news and information agencies, press agencies, communications by computer terminals, broadcasting of television programmes, radio and television programmes (except programmes dedicated to decathlon competitions); electronic mail and data communication services.



**39** Transport, package and storage of goods, travel arrangement, services relating to escorting of travellers, air transport, tourist agencies (except hotel and boarding house reservations), warehousing, packaging of products, storage, rental of warehouses, delivery of goods, rental of cars, transport of valuables.

**40** Treatment of materials, transformation of agricultural products for others (wine-making, distillation, slaughtering, fruit crushing, flour milling; sawing, planing, embroidery, sewing, cutting, polishing, metal coating; dyeing of fabric or clothing, treatment of fabrics against mites, fabric waterproofing, binding of documents, tin-plating, purification and regeneration of air, vulcanization (treatment of materials), video tape editing, photographic printing; fabric waterproofing, binding of documents, tin-plating, purification and regeneration of air, vulcanisation (treatment of materials), video tape editing, photographic printing.

**41** Education, training, entertainment, sporting and cultural activities, publication of books and magazines, lending libraries, animal training, production of shows and films, agencies for actors, rental of films, phonographic recordings, cinema projection apparatus and theatre scenery, organisation of competitions for educational or training purposes; arranging and conducting of colloquiums, conferences and congresses, organization of exhibitions for cultural or educational purposes; (none of the aforesaid services relating to decathlon events).

**42** Providing of food and drink, temporary accommodation, medical, hygienic and beauty care, veterinary and agricultural services, legal services, scientific and industrial research, computer programming, detective agencies, night guards, dating agencies, marriage bureaux, chemical analyses, animal breeding, pet grooming, catering, architecture, copyright management, Turkish baths, videotape recordings, cocktail lounge services, beauty salons, providing of patents, providing of cafes, restaurants, cafeterias, holiday camp services (accommodation); canteens, chiropractors, dating services, hairdressing salons, computer consultancy, evening dress rental, child care facilities, providing campsite facilities, underwater exploration, horoscopes, gardening, licensing of intellectual property, rental of buildings, software development, massages, medical services.
