Article 18

(1) Dans le délai de 3 mois compté de la date de la publication de la marque toute personne peut - moyennant une taxe - faire l'opposition à l'enregistrement de la marque. L'opposition doit être motivée, formée par écrit auprès de la Commission de recours.

Article 39

(5) Les oppositions mentionnées dans l'article 18 peut être déposées dans le délai de 4 mois compté du jour, où le Bureau International a publié dans la gazette l'enregistrement concernant Lettonie en tant qu'un pays désigné.

Article 39³ la protection des marques communautaires, de dispositions supplémentaires

Opposition à l'enregistrement de la marque (18e) et l'exigence d'invalidité marque de (31 CE). Sans cette section 7., 8. et 9. prévue droits antérieurs peuvent également être fondées sur une version antérieure identique ou similaire à la marque avec une bonne réputation dans la Communauté européenne et les produits ou services qui ne sont pas des biens et services similaires, qui a enregistré à une date ultérieure (opposition) marque, mais à la condition que la marque postérieure sans juste motif de l'utilisation de biens ou de services, il est possible de tirer indûment profit du caractère distinctif des marques ou à la réputation ou causer des dommages ou que l'usage de la marque plus tard par les consommateurs comme indiquant un lien entre ces produits ou services et le commerce de la Communauté propriétaire de la marque, ce qui peut nuire aux intérêts du titulaire de la marque. Une telle opposition, ainsi que les réclamations peuvent être soumises au propriétaire de la marque (son successeur) ou son représentant.

Article 7

(1) Selon les dispositions de ladite loi, la marque peut être déclaré nulle

1) lorsqu'elle est identique à une marque antérieure et que les produits ou services pour lesquels la marque a été enregistrée sont identiques à ceux pour lesquels la marque antérieure est protégée

2) lorsqu'en raison de son identité ou de sa similitude avec la marque antérieure et en raison de l'identité ou de la similitude des produits ou des services que les marques désignent, il existe, dans l'esprit du public, un risque de confusion qui comprend le risque d'association avec la marque antérieure

Article 8. marques bien connu comme motif de refus ou invalidation de l'enregistrement

- (1) Nonobstant les dispositions de l'article 7, l'enregistrement d'une marque peut être refusé ou, si elle est enregistrée, l'enregistrement peut être invalidé en vertu des dispositions de la présente loi, si la marque constitue une reproduction, une imitation, une traduction ou une translittération, susceptible de créer une confusion, d'une autre marque, qui, même si enregistrée, était bien connu en Lettonie à l'égard de produits ou services identiques ou similaires, à la date de dépôt de la demande de (contre) l'enregistrement de la marque (ou la date de priorité si une priorité a été accordé).
- (2) Outre les dispositions du paragraphe 1 du présent article, un enregistrement de la marque peut également être refusé ou invalidé si les biens ou services, par rapport à laquelle l'enregistrement de la marque est demandé, ne sont pas similaires à ceux d'une marque qui est bien connu en Lettonie, à condition que les consommateurs peuvent percevoir l'utilisation de la (contre) marque appliquée par rapport à ces produits ou services indique un lien entre ces produits ou services et le propriétaire de la marque notoire, et à condition que cette utilisation peut préjudiciable aux intérêts du propriétaire de la marque bien connue.
- (3) Pour déterminer si une marque est bien connue, il est tenu compte de la connaissance de cette marque dans le groupe de consommateurs concernée, y compris de telles connaissances en Lettonie qui a été obtenu à la suite des activités de publicité ou d'autres circonstances qui ont contribué à sa publicité.
- (4) Pour déterminer si les dispositions des paragraphes 1 et 2 du présent article sont applicables en ce qui concerne un signe qui a été appliquée pour l'enregistrement ou à l'égard d'une marque déposée, il sera tenu compte des dispositions de l'article 6 bis de la Convention de Paris sur les marques bien connues, y compris la mise à disposition sur l'irrecevabilité de la reproduction ou l'imitation de la marque bien connue dans une partie essentielle d'une autre marque; lesdites dispositions sont également applicables, mutatis mutandis, aux marques de services.
- (5) Les dispositions des paragraphes 1 et 2 du présent article en ce qui concerne le refus d'enregistrement ne sont pas applicables pendant la procédure d'examen si la demande d'enregistrement de marque a été déposée avec le consentement du propriétaire de la marque bien connue.

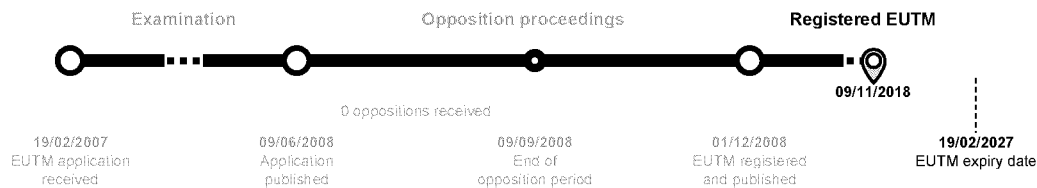

1 Chemicals used in industry, science and photography, as well as in agriculture, horticulture and forestry; unprocessed artificial resins, unprocessed plastics; manures; fire extinguishing compositions; tempering and soldering preparations; chemical substances for preserving foodstuffs; tanning substances; adhesives used in industry; abrasives, acidulated water for recharging accumulators, acetylene, adhesives for wall tiles, acids, industrial chemicals, chemical additives to insecticides, mercury, metalloids, alkaline metals, metal hardening preparation, mordants for metals, foundry molding preparations, radiator flushing chemicals, pyrogalllic acid, rare earths, reagent paper, refrigerants, renovating chemicals, salts for industrial purposes, silicates, sizing preparations, soldering chemicals, solidified gases for industrial purposes, synthetic resins, unprocessed mastic for tires, titanite, transmission fluid, tungstic acid, viscose, wallpaper removing preparations, wax-bleaching chemicals, wood alcohol.

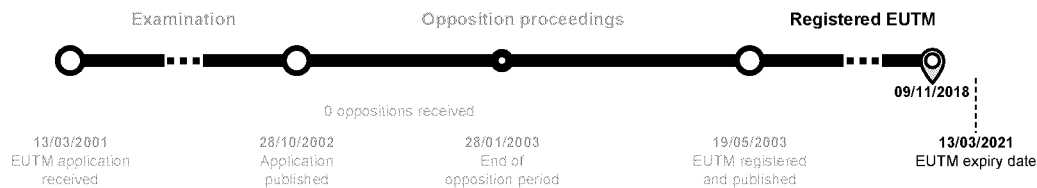

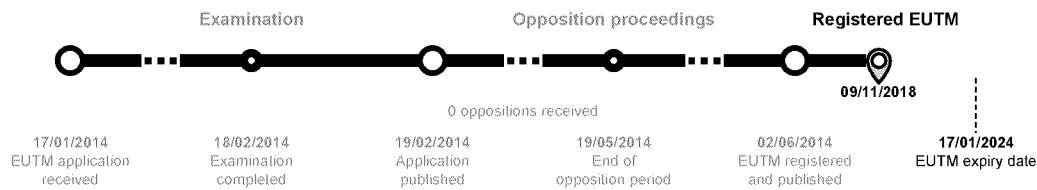
