SUBSTANTIVE REFUSAL

Section 2(d) Refusal - Likelihood of Confusion

Registration of the applied-for mark is refused because of a likelihood of confusion with the mark in U.S. Registration No. 2494905. Trademark Act Section 2(d), 15 U.S.C. §1052(d); see TMEP §§1207.01 et seq. See the enclosed registration.

The applicant has applied to register CORENRG with design for "Acne treatment preparations; adhesive plasters; albumin dietary supplements; albuminous foodstuffs for medical purposes; albuminous preparations for medical purposes; alginate dietary supplements; aloe vera preparations for pharmaceutical purposes; amino acids for medical purposes; antibacterial handwashes; antibacterial soap; antiseptics; antiseptic cotton; antioxidant pills; anti-uric preparations; appetite suppressant pills; appetite suppressants for medical purposes; asthmatic tea; barks for pharmaceutical purposes; bath salts for medical purposes; biological preparations for medical purposes; candy for medical purposes; candy, medicated; casein dietary supplements;

The registered mark is CORENERGY for "nutritional supplements" in Class 005.

Trademark Act Section 2(d) bars registration of an applied-for mark that so resembles a registered mark that it is likely that a potential consumer would be confused, mistaken, or deceived as to the source of the goods and/or services of the applicant and registrant. See 15 U.S.C. §1052(d). In the seminal decision In re E. I. du Pont de Nemours & Co., 476 F.2d 1357, 177 USPQ 563 (C.C.P.A. 1973), the court listed the principal factors to be considered when determining whether there is a likelihood of confusion under Section 2(d). See TMEP §1207.01. However, not all the factors are necessarily relevant or of equal weight, and any one of the factors may control in a given case, depending upon the evidence of record. Citigroup Inc. v. Capital City Bank Grp., Inc., 637 F.3d 1344, 1355, 98 USPQ2d 1253, 1260 (Fed. Cir. 2011); In re Majestic Distilling Co., 315 F.3d 1311, 1315, 65 USPQ2d 1201, 1204 (Fed. Cir. 2003); see In re E. I. du Pont de Nemours & Co., 476 F.2d at 1361-62, 177 USPQ at 567.

In this case, the following factors are the most relevant: similarity of the marks, similarity and nature of the goods and/or services, and similarity of the trade channels of the goods and/or services. See In re Viterra Inc., 671 F.3d 1358, 1361-62, 101 USPQ2d 1905, 1908 (Fed. Cir. 2012); In re Dakin's Miniatures Inc., 59 USPQ2d 1593, 1595-96 (TTAB 1999); TMEP §§1207.01 et seq.

Taking into account the relevant *du Pont* factors, a likelihood of confusion determination in this case involves a two-part analysis. *See In re E. I. du Pont de Nemours & Co.*, 476 F.2d 1357, 1361-62, 177 USPQ 563, 567 (C.C.P.A. 1973); *In re 1st USA Realty Prof'ls Inc.*, 84 USPQ2d 1581, 1584 (TTAB 2007); *see also In re Dixie Rests. Inc.*, 105 F.3d 1405, 1406-07, 41 USPQ2d 1531, 1533 (Fed. Cir. 1997). The marks are compared for similarities in their appearance, sound, connotation and commercial impression. TMEP §§1207.01, 1207.01(b). The goods and/or services are compared to determine whether they are similar or commercially related or travel in the same trade channels. *See Herbko Int'l, Inc. v. Kappa Books, Inc.*, 308 F.3d 1156, 1164-65, 64 USPQ2d 1375, 1380 (Fed. Cir. 2002); *Han Beauty, Inc. v. Alberto-Culver Co.*, 236 F.3d 1333, 1336, 57 USPQ2d 1557, 1559 (Fed. Cir. 2001); TMEP §§1207.01, 1207.01(a)(vi).

The Trademark Trial and Appeal Board and its primary reviewing court have used a stricter standard to determine likelihood of confusion for pharmaceuticals or medicinal products due to the potential harm or serious consequences that could be caused if the public confused one drug or medicinal product for another. See Glenwood Labs., Inc. v. Am. Home Prods. Corp., 455 F.2d 1384, 1386-87, 173 USPQ 19, 21-22 (C.C.P.A. 1972); Schering Corp. v. Alza Corp., 207 USPQ 504, 509 (TTAB 1980); Ethicon, Inc. v. Am. Cyanamid Co., 192 USPQ 647, 651-52 (TTAB 1976); TMEP §1207.01(d)(xii). Although physicians and pharmacists are no doubt carefully trained to recognize differences in the characteristics of pharmaceuticals or medicinal products, they are not immune from mistaking similar trademarks used on these goods. See Alfacell Corp. v. Anticancer Inc., 71 USPQ2d 1301, 1305-06 (TTAB 2004); Blansett Pharmacal Co. v. Carmrick Labs., Inc., 25 USPQ2d 1473, 1477 (TTAB 1992); Schering Corp., 207 USPQ at 509. Thus, in this case where confusion could result in harm or other serious consequences to consumers, this potential harm is considered an additional relevant factor and a lesser degree of proof may be sufficient to establish a likelihood of confusion. See Glenwood Labs., Inc., 455 F.2d at 1386-87, 173 USPQ at 21-22; Schering Corp., 207 USPQ at 509; Ethicon, Inc., 192 USPQ at 651-52; TMEP §1207.01(d)(xii).

Comparison of the Marks

Marks are compared in their entireties for similarities in appearance, sound, connotation, and commercial impression. In re Viterra Inc., 671 F.3d 1358, 1362, 101 USPQ2d 1905, 1908 (Fed. Cir. 2012) (quoting In re E. I. du Pont de Nemours & Co., 476 F.2d 1357, 1361, 177 USPQ 563, 567 (C.C.P.A. 1973)); TMEP §1207.01(b)-(b)(v). Similarity in any one of these elements may be sufficient to find the marks confusingly similar. In re White Swan Ltd., 8 USPQ2d 1534, 1535 (TTAB 1988); see In re 1st USA Realty Prof ls, Inc., 84 USPQ2d 1581, 1586 (TTAB 2007); TMEP §1207.01(b).

In the present case, applicant's mark CORENRG is similar to the registered mark CORENERGY in sound, appearance, and connotation. There is no correct pronunciation of a mark because it is impossible to predict how the public will pronounce a particular mark. *See Embarcadero Techs., Inc. v. RStudio, Inc.*, 105 USPQ2d 1825, 1835 (TTAB 2013) (quoting *In re Viterra Inc.*, 671 F.3d 1358, 1367, 101 USPQ2d 1905, 1912 (Fed. Cir. 2012); *In re The Belgrade Shoe Co.*, 411 F.2d 1352, 1353, 162 USPQ 227, 227 (C.C.P.A. 1969)); TMEP §1207.01(b)(iv). The marks in question

could clearly be pronounced the same; such similarity in sound alone may be sufficient to support a finding that the marks are confusingly similar. *In re White Swan Ltd.*, 8 USPQ2d 1534, 1535 (TTAB 1988); *see In re 1st USA Realty Prof'ls, Inc.*, 84 USPQ2d 1581, 1586 (TTAB 2007); TMEP §1207.01(b)(iv).

Further, although the applicant's mark contains a design element, consumers are likely to place greater weight on the word portion of the mark. When evaluating a composite mark consisting of words and a design, the word portion is normally accorded greater weight because it is likely to make a greater impression upon purchasers, be remembered by them, and be used by them to refer to or request the goods and/or services. *In re Aquitaine Wine USA, LLC*, 126 USPQ2d 1181, 1184 (TTAB 2018) (citing *In re Viterra Inc.*, 671 F.3d 1358, 1362, 101 USPQ2d 1905, 1908 (Fed. Cir. 2012)); TMEP §1207.01(c)(ii). Thus, although marks must be compared in their entireties, the word portion is often considered the dominant feature and is accorded greater weight in determining whether marks are confusingly similar, even where the word portion has been disclaimed. *In re Viterra Inc.*, 671 F.3d at 1366-67, 101 USPQ2d at 1911 (citing *Giant Food, Inc. v. Nation's Foodservice, Inc.*, 710 F.2d 1565, 1570-71, 218 USPQ2d 390, 395 (Fed. Cir. 1983)).

Overall, the marks have the same commercial impression.

Comparison of Goods

The goods and/or services of the parties need not be identical or even competitive to find a likelihood of confusion. See On-line Careline Inc. v. Am. Online Inc., 229 F.3d 1080, 1086, 56 USPQ2d 1471, 1475 (Fed. Cir. 2000); Recot, Inc. v. Becton, 214 F.3d 1322, 1329, 54 USPQ2d 1894, 1898 (Fed. Cir. 2000) ("[E]ven if the goods in question are different from, and thus not related to, one another in kind, the same goods can be related in the mind of the consuming public as to the origin of the goods."); TMEP §1207.01(a)(i).

The respective goods and/or services need only be "related in some manner and/or if the circumstances surrounding their marketing [be] such that they could give rise to the mistaken belief that [the goods and/or services] emanate from the same source." *Coach Servs., Inc. v. Triumph Learning LLC*, 668 F.3d 1356, 1369, 101 USPQ2d 1713, 1722 (Fed. Cir. 2012) (quoting *T-Eleven Inc. v. Wechsler*, 83 USPQ2d 1715, 1724 (TTAB 2007)); *Gen. Mills Inc. v. Fage Dairy Processing Indus. SA*, 100 USPQ2d 1584, 1597 (TTAB 2011); TMEP §1207.01(a)(i).

Specifically, both applicant and registrant have identified various types of related supplements, such as "albumin dietary supplements;" "alginate dietary supplements;" "casein dietary supplements;" "fecithin dietary supplements;" "finiseed dietary supplements;" "mineral food supplements;" "nutritional supplements;" "pollen dietary supplements;" "propolis dietary supplements;" "royal jelly dietary supplements;" "wheat germ dietary supplements;" and "yeast dietary supplements;" "and "yeast dietary supplements;" "the supplements;" "supplements;" "and "yeast dietary supplements;" "supplements;" "sup supplements.'

The trademark examining attorney has attached evidence from the USPTO's X-Search database consisting of a number of third-party marks registered for use in connection with the same or similar goods and/or services as those of both applicant and registrant in this case. This evidence shows that the goods and/or services listed therein, namely various goods identified by the applicant and nutritional supplements, are of a kind that may emanate from a single source under a single mark. See In re I-Coat Co., 126 USPQ2d 1730, 1737 (TTAB 2018) (citing In re Infinity Broad. Corp., 60 USPQ2d 1214, 1217-18 (TTAB 2001); In re Albert Trostel & Sons Co., 29 USPQ2d 1783, 1785-86 (TTAB 1993); In re Mucky Duck Mustard Co., 6 USPQ2d 1467, 1470 n.6 (TTAB 1988)); TMEP §1207.01(d)(iii).

Accordingly, the goods and/or services would be sold to the same class of purchasers and encountered under circumstances leading one to mistakenly believe the goods and/or services originate from the same source.

Since the marks are similar and the goods and/or services are related, there is a likelihood of confusion as to the source of the applicant's goods and/or services. Therefore, applicant's mark is not entitled to registration.

Although applicant's mark has been refused registration, applicant may respond to the refusal(s) by submitting evidence and arguments in support of registration.

If applicant responds to the refusal(s), applicant must also respond to the requirement(s) set forth below.

Identification of Goods and/or Services Requirement

The identification of goods and/or services contains brackets. Generally, parentheses and brackets should *not* be used in identifications. TMEP §1402.12. The USPTO generally uses brackets to indicate goods and/or services that have been deleted from registrations. *See id.* Parenthetical information is permitted in identifications only if it serves to explain or translate the matter immediately preceding the parenthetical phrase in such a way that it does not affect the clarity of the identification, e.g., "obi (Japanese sash)." *Id.*

Therefore, applicant must remove the brackets from the identification and incorporate any parenthetical or bracketed information into the description of the goods and/or services.

The identification of goods and/or services is indefinite and must be clarified because various elements in the wording are excessively broad and may include goods/services in multiple international classes. The examining attorney notes below in bold where additional specification/clarification is needed. See TMEP §§1402.01, 1402.03(a).

Applicant may amend the identification to list only those items that are within the scope of the goods and/or services set forth in the application or within the scope of a previously accepted amendment to the identification. See 37 C.F.R. §2.71(a); TMEP §§1402.06 et seq., 1402.07.

The international classification of goods and/or services in applications filed under Trademark Act Section 66(a) cannot be changed from the classification the International Bureau assigned to the goods and/or services in the corresponding international registration. TMEP §§1401.03(d), 1904.02(b).

Therefore, any modification to this wording must identify goods and/or services that are within the scope of the goods and/or services set forth in the present identification.
