Representation

Art. 3. (1) Any person having the right under this Law to conduct business with the Patent Office may do so either in person or through a local industrial property agent.

(2) (amended - State Gazette No. 43/2005, in force since 21.08.2005) Those persons provided for in paragraph (1) who have no residence or headquarters in the Republic of Bulgaria shall conduct business with the Patent Office through a local industrial property agent.

Relative Grounds for Refusal of Registration (title amend. - SG 73/06, in force from 06.10.2006)

Art. 12. (1) (amend. – SG 19/10, in force from 10.03.2011) In case of opposition filed under Art. 38b shall not be registered a mark:

- 1. (suppl. – SG 19/10, in force from 10.03.2011) which is identical with an earlier mark when the commodities or the services of the declared one and of the earlier mark are identical.
- 2. (suppl. – SG 19/10, in force from 10.03.2011) when, due to its identity or similarity

with an earlier mark and the identity or the similarity of the commodities or the services of the two marks there is a probability for confusion of the users including the opportunity for connection with the earlier mark;

3. (revoked – SG 19/10, in force from 10.03.2011)

(2) (amend. – SG 19/10, in force from 10.03.2011) An earlier mark in the sense of para 1 shall be:

1. a mark with earlier filing date of the application or earlier priority, registered under this Law;

2. an applied mark with earlier filing date or earlier priority, in case being registered under this Law;

3. a mark registered under the Madrid Agreement or the Protocol with earlier date of registration or earlier priority and acknowledged effect on the territory of the Republic of Bulgaria;

4. a mark registered under the Madrid Agreement or the Protocol with earlier date of registration or earlier priority in case its effect being acknowledged on the territory of the Republic of Bulgaria;

5. a Community mark with earlier filing date of the application or earlier priority, or earlier seniority for the territory of the Republic of Bulgaria, acknowledged under the order of Regulation (EC) No 207/2009 of the Council of 26 February 2009 regarding the Community trademark (OJ, L 78/1 of 24 March 2009), hereinafter referred to as "Regulation (EC) No 207/2009";

6. an applied Community mark with earlier filing date of the application or earlier priority, or earlier seniority for the territory of the Republic of Bulgaria, acknowledged under Regulation (EC) No 207/2009, in case it being registered under this Regulation;

7. a mark which is widely known on the territory of the Republic of Bulgaria by the date of submitting an application for a mark, respectively by the date of priority.

(3) (amend. SG 43/05) A mark identical with or similar to an earlier mark and designated for commodities or services which are not identical with or similar to these for which the earlier mark has been registered when the earlier mark is well-known on the territory of the Republic of Bulgaria and the use of the declared mark would lead to unfair benefits from the distinctive character or the popularity of the earlier mark or will degrade them, shall not be registered.

(4) The provisions of para 1, item 2 and para 3 shall not be applied upon consent by the owner of the earlier mark.

(5) (new – SG 19/10, in force from 10.03.2011) In case of opposition filed by the actual holder of a mark, no mark shall be registered, if filed by the agent or the representative of the actual holder without the consent of the latter.

(6) (new – SG 19/10, in force from 10.03.2011) In case of opposition filed by the actual holder of a non-registered mark used in the commercial activity on the territory of the Republic of Bulgaria, no mark shall be registered which filing date is later than the date of the actual commercial use of the non-registered mark.

Objections by third parties

Art. 38a. (new – SG 19/10, in force from 10.03.2011) (1) Within three months from the date of publication of the application any natural or legal person, as well as associations representing manufacturers, producers, providers of services, merchants or consumers, may file an objection against the registration of a mark on the grounds of Art. 11.

(2) The objection shall be filed in writing and shall be grounded and reasoned.

(3) The person that has filed the objection shall not be deemed participant in the registration procedure.

(4) The objection shall be sent to the applicant who may state his opinion thereto.

(5) The objection shall be decided upon by the opposition department.

Opposition against the registration

Art. 38b. (new – SG 19/10, in force from 10.03.2011) (1) The holder of an earlier mark in the sense of Art.12, Para 2 and 3, the exclusive licensee of an earlier mark, the actual owner of a non-registered mark, used in commercial activity on the territory of the Republic of Bulgaria and applied for registration, as well as a holder of a mark, applied for by an agent or representative of the holder without the consent of the latter, may file an opposition on the grounds of Art.12, Para 1 against:

1. the registration of a mark, applied for under this Law;
2. the recognition of the effect of an international registration on the territory of the Republic of Bulgaria.

(2) The opposition under Para 1, Item 1 shall be filed within three months from the publication of the applied mark in the official bulletin of the Patent Office.

(3) The opposition under Para 1, Item 2 shall be filed between the 6th and the 9th month after the publication of the international registration in the official bulletin of the Patent Office.

(4) The opposition shall be filed in two copies, it shall be reasoned, shall contain information of the filing person, of the opposed mark, the legal grounds it is based on, and shall be accompanied by evidence, if necessary. When the opposition is based on a well-known mark or on a mark with reputation, it shall be accompanied by evidence of its well known status or reputation.

(5) The opposition shall be accompanied by a document for paid fees.

(6) The applicant of the opposed mark shall be notified in case of opposition under Para 1, Item 1.

(7) The International Bureau shall be notified in case of opposition under Para 1, Item 2.

Check of the admissibility and the formal validity of the opposition

Art. 38c. (new – SG 19/10, in force from 10.03.2011) (1) Each opposition shall be checked for compliance with the requirements of Art. 38b, Para 1, 2 and 3.

(2) Any opposition not filed within the time limit, and/or lacking paid fees within the time limit under Art. 38b, Para 2, or not filed by a person under Para 1 shall be inadmissible and shall not give rise to a procedure, of which the filing person shall be notified.

(3) Each admissible opposition shall be checked for compliance with the requirements of Art. 38b, Para 4 and where deficiencies have been found the filing person shall be notified and given a two-month time limit for correcting them. Where the deficiencies are not corrected within the time limit, a decision for terminating the procedure shall be taken.

Opposition proceedings

Art. 38d. (new – SG 19/10, in force from 10.03.2011) (1) The opposition shall be considered by panels of the opposition department consisting of three experts, one being the chairman of the panel.

(2) One of the copies of the opposition, together with the evidence, shall be sent to the applicant of the mark being opposed. Simultaneously, a notification shall be sent to the both parties that they are provided a three-month time limit to reach an agreement commencing from the date of sending the notification. This time limit may be extended twice by three months at request in writing signed by the parties.

(3) When the parties submit an agreement on the dispute according to Para 2, the proceedings shall be terminated.

(4) When no agreement has been submitted within the time limit under Para 2, the applicant of the opposed mark shall be provided a two-month time limit to respond to the opposition. If the applicant of the opposed mark fails to respond within that time limit, a

decision based on the opposition and the supplied evidence shall be delivered.

(5) The response of the applicant of the opposed mark shall be sent to the person that has filed the opposition and the latter shall be provided one month to state his opinion.

(6) At the request of the applicant of the opposed mark, the person that has filed the opposition shall present evidence for genuine use of the earlier mark during the 5 years preceding the publication of the application of the opposed mark, or evidence for the reasons justifying the lack of use, provided that the earlier has been registered at least 5 years before the date of filing the opposition. The person that has filed the opposition shall be provided a two-month term to furnish such evidence. If no such evidence has been furnished, a decision for rejecting the opposition as groundless shall be taken.

(7) The request under Para 6 shall be made at the first opportunity given to the applicant to respond to the opposition.

(8) Within 6 months from the exchange of correspondence between the parties the panel from the opposition department shall consider the opposition, the opinion of the applicant of the opposed mark and of the person that has filed the opposition, as well as the supplied evidence, if available, and shall deliver a decision.

(9) When the opposition is unfounded, a decision for its rejection shall be taken.

(10) When the opposition is founded, a decision shall be taken for partial or full refusal to register the opposed mark.

(11) The order for drawing up, filing and considering oppositions shall be determined in an ordinance of the Council of Ministers.

IX. Information relating to subsequent procedure:

(i) Time limit for requesting review or appeal: **three months** from the date of issue of the refusal to reach an agreement with the opponent;

(ii) Authority to which such request for review or appeal should be made:
Patent Office of the Republic of Bulgaria

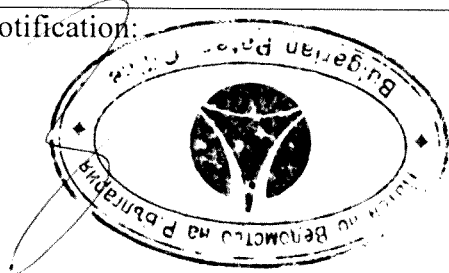
The agreement between the parties must be presented to the **Patent Office of the Republic of Bulgaria only through an Industrial Property Representatives (agents)** residing in Bulgaria.

In the absence of an agreement within the prescribed period, the holder of the international registration has **an additional period of two months** to submit to the Patent Office of the Republic of Bulgaria, **through a representative** domiciled in Bulgaria, its response to the provisional refusal based on opposition.

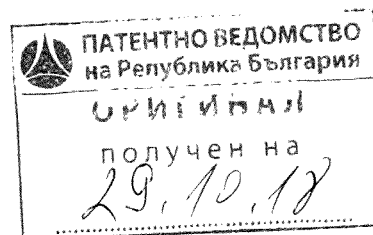

Уважаеми господа,

Упълномощена съм от Emil Lux GmbH & Co. KG да подам настоящата опозиция срещу международна регистрация на марка **LUX**, международен регистров номер 1387991, притежател GUANGZHOU DARING INTERNATIONAL FORWARDING CO., LTD. за всички заявени стоки от клас 25.

В брой 02.2/2018 на Официалния бюлетин на Патентното ведомство на 28.02.2018 е

публикувана международната регистрация на марка **LUX**, номер 1387991, притежател GUANGZHOU DARING INTERNATIONAL FORWARDING CO., LTD., за стоки от клас 25.

Emil Lux GmbH & Co. KG е притежател на следните предходно регистрирани марки:

1. Марка в ЕС - **LUX TOOLS** – комбинирана, номер 011147345, дата на заявяване 29.08.2012 за стоки и услуги от класове 1, 3, 4, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 24, 25, 26 (**Марка 1**).
2. Марка в ЕС – **LUX** – словна, номер 011147361, дата на заявяване 29.08.2012, за стоки и услуги от класове 1, 3, 4, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 12, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 26 (**Марка 2**).

Тези две марки са по-ранни марка по смисъла на чл.12 ал.1 т.2 от ЗМГО по отношение на атакуваната марка.

Считам, че между по-ранните марки на Emil Lux GmbH & Co. KG и международна регистрация номер 1387991 е налице обръкващо сходство между марките и идентичност и сходство на стоките от класове 22, 25 и 26, поради следните съображения.

Вероятността от обръкване на потребителите се преценява чрез оценката на фонетично, визуално и смислово сходство, като за степента на сходство се преценява въз основа на общото впечатление от марката.

Общата оценка на вероятността от обръкване по отношение фонетичното, визуалното и

смысловото сходство между марките, следва да се основава на общото впечатление от марките, като се вземат предвид техните отличителни и доминиращи елементи (*ECJ, 3 септември 2009, Aceites del Sur-Coosur/OHIM - Koipe Corporacion, C-498/07 P, параграфи 60-70*).

Под отличителен елемент се разбира този елемент в състава на марките, който в най-голяма степен служи за осъществяване на основната функция на марката – да отличава стоките и/или услугите на едно лице от тези на други лица. Доминиращ елемент е този, който благодарение на графичното си представяне или по друг начин обуславя общото впечатление, което марката оставя у потребителите.

Заявената марка е комбинирана, словната част се състои от една дума на латиница – **LUX**, изписана с удебелен шрифт, без някаква отличителност. Тъй като заявената марка няма характерен образен елемент, то отличителен и доминиращ елемент е словната част **LUX**.

По-ранната **Марка 1** е комбинирана, състои се от словна част **LUX**, изписана хоризонтално и вертикално с обща буква **U**, композицията със словната част **LUX** е вписана в окръжност с бял цвят. Под словната част **LUX** е разположена словна част **TOOLS**. Словните елементи са изобразени с бял цвят на син правоъгълен фон. Отличителен елемент е словната част **LUX**, тъй като **TOOLS** в превод от английски език означава „средства, инструменти“ и термин, който е няма отличителен характер. Доминиращ елемент е също словната част **LUX**, поради своето централно разположение и размер.

По-ранната **Марка 2** е словна, следователно отличителен и доминиращ елемент е словната част **LUX**.

Съгласно Методическите указания на ПВ „оценката на фонетичното сходство се основава на звученето на марките, определено от дължината на думата, броя на буквите, броя на сричките, броя на съвпадащите звуци, взаимно разположение на еднакви или близки звуци или звукосъчетания, характерни особености на еднакви части на думата, като се отчита началото на думата, типични окончания и типични звукосъчетания в средата на думата“.

По-ранната **Марка 1** се състои от две думи на латиница. Атакуваната марка се състои от една дума на латиница. Двете марки имат идентична обща словна част - **LUX**, която е доминираща и отличителна в по-ранната марка и единствената дума в атакуваната марка. От фонетична гледна точка, при произнасяне на марките има идентичност по отношение на първата дума от по-ранната марка и различие по отношение на втората дума, която не присъства в атакуваната марка. Произношението на втората дума на по-ранната марка не влияе обаче върху фонетичното сходство, тъй като е елемент без отличителен характер.

Освен това, съгласно Методическите указания на Патентното ведомство, при словните елементи, първата част на марката е тази, която преимуществено привлича вниманието на потребителя и поради тази причина ще бъде запомнена по-ясно от останалата ѝ част. Еднаквото начало има значително влияние върху цялостното впечатление създавано от марките и увеличава сходството между тях (*решение от 15/12/2009, T-412/08, Trubion, EU:T:2009:507, § 40; 25/03/2009, T-109/07, Spa Therapy, EU:T:2009:81, § 30*).

Между по-ранната **Марка 2** и атакуваната марка е налице фонетична идентичност.

В резултат на изброените по-горе прилики, между по-ранната **Марка 1** и атакуваната марка е налице и силно визуално сходство. Марките съдържат общ отличителен елемент LUX. Словната част на заявената марка не е изобразена с отличителен и необичаен шрифт, който да създаде различно визуално впечатление. Следователно между марките е налице визуално сходство в много висока степен.

Между по-ранната **Марка 2** и атакуваната марка е налице почти визуална идентичност.

Когато две сравнявани марки имат обща дума или израз, в този случай между марките има смислово сходство. Всички сравнявани марки съдържат словната част **LUX** като отделна дума, която има смислово значение на различни езици, като „лукс“, „единицата за осветеност лукс“ и т.н. Поради тази причина между **Марка 1** и атакуваната марка има силно смислово сходство. Между **Марка 2** и атакуваната марка има смислова идентичност.

От всичко изложено до тук следва извода, че между марка **LUX** и по-ранните марки **LUX TOOLS** и **LUX** на опонента е налице фонетично, визуално фонетично сходство и идентичност в много висока степен, което би довело до объркване на потребителите и вероятност от свързване с по-ранните марки на опонента.

Сравнение между стоките

Настоящата опозиция се подава по отношение на всички стоки от клас 25, за които е заявена марка LUX:

Преводът на списъка със стоки от клас 25 е направен съгласно терминологията от TM Class.

Стоките, за които е защитена по-ранна **Марка 1** и въз основа на които е подадена настоящата опозиция са следните:

- 22 - EN Ropes, string, nets, tents, awnings, tarpaulins, sails, sacks and bags (so far as included in class 22); Raw fibrous textile materials.
- 22 - BG Въжета, канап, мрежи, навеси, чергила, брезент, корабни платна, торби и чанти (доколкото са включени в клас 22); Текстилни материали от необработени влакна.
- 25 - EN Clothing, footwear, headgear.
- 25 - BG Облекло, обувки, шапки и принадлежности за глава.
- 26 - EN Ribbons and braid; Buttons, hooks and eyes, pins and needles; Velcro.
- 26 - BG Панделки и панделка; Копчета, телени копчета, карфици и игли; Прилепващи ленти (галантерия).

Стоките, за които е защитена по-ранна **Марка 2** и въз основа на които е подадена настоящата опозиция са следните:

- 22 - EN Ropes, string, nets, tents, tarpaulins, sacks and bags (so far as included in class 22); Raw fibrous textile materials.
- 22 - BG Въжета, Връв, Мрежи, Тенти, Брезенти (Импрегнирани с катран -), Сакове и чанти (включени в клас 22); Текстилни материали от необработени влакна.
- 26 - EN Hooks and eyes, pins and needles; Velcro.
- 26 - BG Кукички и халки, игли; Прилепващи ленти (галантерия).

Стоките на атакуваната марка: „Облекло; Обувки; Шапки и принадлежности за глава“ са идентични на стоките от клас 25 на **Марка 1** „Облекло, обувки, шапки и принадлежности за глава“.

Останалите заявени стоки „Тениски; Защитни работни костюми; Трикотажно и плетено облекло; Трикотаж; Шалчета; Кожени колани [облекло]“ също са идентични на стоките „Облекло; шапки и принадлежности за глава“ на **Марка 1**. Идентичност съществува не само когато стоките и услугите напълно съвпадат (т.е. използват се същите термини или синоними), но и когато и когато стоките/услугите на атакуваната марка попадат в по-широката категория на по-ранната марка. Когато списъкът на стоките и или услугите на по-ранната марка включва общо указание или широка категория, обхващаща стоките/услугите на атакуваната марка в тяхната цялост, стоките и услугите са идентични (*решение на EUIPO от 17/01/2012, T-522/10 'Hell', параграф 36*).

Между стоките от клас 22 „Въжета, Връв, Мрежи, Тенти, Брезенти (Импрегнирани с катран), Сакове и чанти (включени в клас 22); Текстилни материали от необработени влакна“ и клас

26 „Кукички и халки, игли; Прилепващи ленти (галантерия)“ на Марка 2 е също е налице сходство. Тези стоки са допълващи се, а голяма част от тях се използват за производството на стоките от клас 5 – облекло и обувки. Освен това, съгласно практиката на СЕС, при преценката на вероятността за объркване трябва да се има предвид, че сходството на марките и сходството на стоките и/или услугите са взаимно зависими, в смисъл че по-ниската степен на сходство на стоките и/или услугите може да се компенсира от по-високата степен на сходство на марките и обратно (*Решение СЕС, C-39/97 „Canon”, параграф 17*). Тъй като Марка 2 и атакуваната марка са идентични, дори и наличието на по-ниска степен на сходство между стоките би създавало вероятност от объркване на потребителите.

Поради объркващото сходството на по-ранните марки на опонента със заявената марка **LUX** и поради идентичността и сходството на стоките от клас 25 съществува вероятност от объркване на потребителите, което включва възможност за свързване с регистрираните по-ранни марки.

В заключение марка **LUX**, IR 1387991 не отговаря на изискванията на чл.12, а.1, т.2 от ЗМГО по отношение на всички стоки от клас 25.

Моля да вземете под внимание настоящата опозиция и да постановите решение за отказ от регистрация на марка **LUX**, IR 1387991 за всички стоки от клас 25.

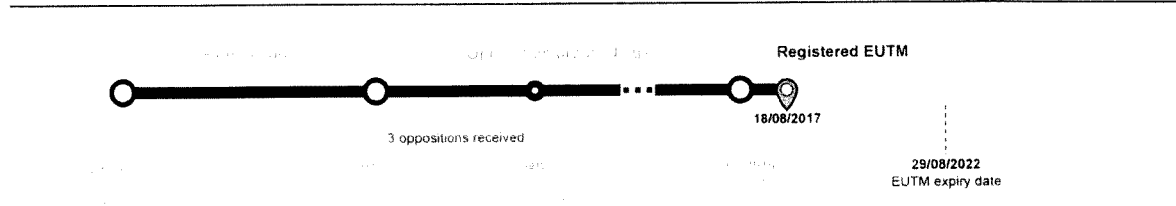

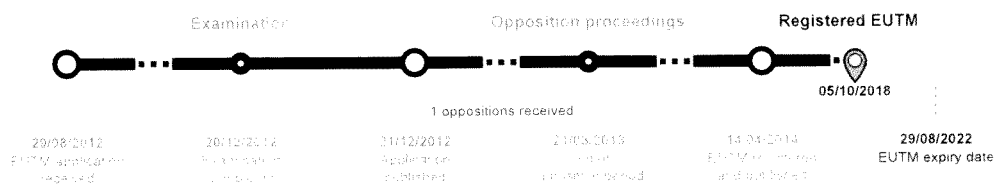
