

V.	Grounds for refusal: The verbal element "PREMIUM" of the presented trademark "Sahara PREMIUM" is descriptive, used to characterize the claimed goods of the class 02.
VI.	Corresponding essential provisions of the applicable law: Article 10.08 of the Law of the Republic of Uzbekistan «on Trade Marks and Service Marks and Appellations of Origin»
VII.
