By this notification, the United States Patent and Trademark Office (USPTO) hereby asserts that the effects of the international registration above are invalidated in part with respect to the United States of America.

The partial invalidation was pronounced by the Director of the USPTO pursuant to Section 71 of the U.S. Trademark Act after the holder failed to comply with the statutory requirements regarding the filing of an affidavit of continued use or excusable nonuse for some of the goods and/or services in the time allowed for the corresponding registered extension of protection, U.S. Registration No. 5047456. 15 U.S.C. §1141k.

Goods/Services Are Limited To:

- (29) Preserved fruit and vegetables, jams, edible olive oil; pickles.
- (30) Vinegar, bakery goods and dessert items, namely, cakes, cookies, pastries, candies, and frozen confections; chocolate confections, confectionery made of sugar; sweets, biscuits, bread, pasta, honey, sauces.
- (33) Alcoholic drinks except beers, alcoholic extracts, liqueurs and spirits, wines, sparkling wines, grappas.

The effective date of the partial invalidation of protection for these goods/services is March 22, 2023.

The invalidation is no longer subject to appeal.
