(Class 37) Refurbishment, maintenance, repair of injection molding machine, equipment and related components thereof, namely steel molds used to produce plastic parts, product handling equipment namely, conveyors, stackers, sorters, packers, cranes, automated lifting and clamping devices to lift and clamp injection molded parts, computers with firmware and a human machine interface for controlling the operation of injection molding machines, robots for removing molded plastic parts from an industrial steel mold.

(Class 42) Providing engineering and technical troubleshooting support on the operation and maintenance of injection molding machinery, equipment and related components thereof, namely steel molds used to produce plastic parts, product handling equipment namely, conveyors, stackers, sorters, packers, cranes, automated lifting and clamping devices to lift and clamp injection molded parts, computers with firmware and a human machine interface for controlling the operation of injection molding machines, robots for removing molded plastic parts from an industrial steel mold.
