The mark is accepted for the following goods and services:

Class 9 Scientific, nautical, surveying, electric, photographic, cinematographic, optical, weighing, measuring, signalling, checking (supervision), life-saving and teaching apparatus and instruments not included in other classes; apparatus for recording, transmission or reproduction of sound or images; recorded and non-recorded carriers for sound and images (with exception of unexposed films); magnetic data carriers; recording discs; cassettes; videos; compact discs; DVDs (Digital Versatile Discs); CD-Roms; floppy discs; slides; computer games, video games as peripheral devices for TV-sets; computer programs; automatic vending machines and mechanisms for coin-operated apparatus; cash registers, calculating machines, data processing equipment and computers; computer peripheral devices; spectacles (optics); sunglasses; spectacle cases; fire-extinguishing apparatus; video games.

Class 16 Printed matter; books, newspapers, magazines, bookbinding material; photographs; stationery; adhesives for stationery or household purposes; artists' materials; paint brushes, typewriters and office requisites (except furniture); instructional and teaching material (except apparatus); printers' type; printing blocks.


Class 28 Games and playthings; plush animals; automatic and coin-operated amusement machines; electronic games other than those adapted for use with television receivers; playing cards; gymnastic and sporting articles not included in other classes; decorations for Christmas trees.

Class 41 Education; training, entertainment, in particular broadcast, movie and television entertainment; organization, hosting and performance of events, namely cultural and/or sports events and/or events serving entertainment purposes; broadcast, movie and television productions; rental and exploitation of movies for cinema and television; sports and cultural activities; publishing and editing of periodicals, newspapers and books as print media and on electronic data carriers as well as in local, regional, national and international computer networks.
