Class 35- Specification

The term 'Intermediary services in commerce relating to the goods included in Classes 5 and 29' is unacceptable under Section 1(1) and 3(1)(a) of the Act in that it is too vague and lacks legal clarity. As the specification is unclear in this respect, it will not be possible for the sign to distinguish the services of one undertaking from those of another.

To overcome this refusal, you should list the services by name and restrict them, or provide information to show that the list of services accurately describes the range of services for which the mark is used, or going to be used in the UK.
