I must advise you that following receipt of an opposition to the above Trade Mark, it is necessary to issue this formal provisional refusal letter. This provisional refusal covers all of the goods and services of the International Registration.

STATEMENT OF GROUNDS

- The opponent is the registered proprietor of the following trade mark:
 - UK Registration No. 2456752 28 twentyeight / 28 twentyeight (Figurative) (series
 of 2) in classes 3 and 4.
- 2. Full details of this earlier mark are identified in the Notice of Opposition and attachments.
- The opponent is therefore the proprietor of an earlier trade mark for the purposes of Section 6 of the UK Trade Marks Act 1994.
- The mark opposed, International Registration No. 1033667 designating the United Kingdom, is an application to register the mark 28BLACK in classes 3, 25, 32 and 33.
- The identical "28" element is wholly contained within 28BLACK. 28 is distinctive in relation to the goods of interest. The other element of the opponent's UK Registration No. 2456752 is "twentyeight" which is phonetically identical to "28".
- The mark subject of International Registration No. 1033667 designating the United Kingdom is therefore similar to the opponent's earlier registration listed in paragraph 1.
- 7. The opponent's Registration No. 2458752 covers "bleaching preparations and other substances for laundry use; cleaning, polishing, acouring and abrasive preparations; soaps; essential oils, cosmetics, hair lotions; dentrifices" in class 3.
- 8. The mark subject of International Registration No. 1033667 designating the United Kingdom covers "perfumery, essential oils, hair lotions, cosmetics" in class 3.
- 9. The following goods are therefore identical: "essential oils, hair lotions, cosmetics".

- 10. Insofar as "perfumery" is not identical to the goods contained within the opponent's earlier trade mark in paragraph 1, it is very closely similar. "Perfumery" is of a similar nature to the other goods, particularly in relation to "essential oils", both being substances, extracts or preparations for diffusing agreeable or attractive smells. "Perfumery" is also of a similar nature to "hair lotions" and "cosmetics" insofar as they are all beauty or self improvement products. They therefore all have similar uses, namely to beautify or enhance an individual's appearance. In addition "perfumery" is sold alongside goods covered by the opponent's trade mark (particularly cosmetics and hair lotions) in retail outlets, such as department stores, chemists and supermarkets. The channels of trade are therefore identical.
- 11. The mark subject of International Registration No. 1033667 designating the United Kingdom covers "Clothing, namely sports and leisure clothing; shoes, footwear and boots, namely sports and leisure shoes and boots; stockings, pants, socks; suspenders, also made of leather; ties, namely bow ties; gloves; headgear, namely headbands and sweatbands; beits" in class 25. These class 25 goods are similar to the goods covered by the opponent's earlier Registration No. 2456752 insofar as they have the same users and channels of trade, such that there would be a likelihood of confusion, including a likelihood of association, between the marks. For example, this is because manufacturers who sell clothing also often have associated perfumery and cosmetics product lines, for example CHANEL, HUGO BOSS and GIVENCHY, and such products in classes 3 and 25 will therefore be thought of by the average consumer as coming from the same undertaking.
- 12. As a result of the foregoing, the mark subject of International Registration No. 1033667 designating the United Kingdom is similar to the opponent's earlier trade mark referred to in paragraph 1, and is to be registered for goods identical with and similar to those covered by the opponent's earlier mark. As such, there exists a likelihood of confusion on the part of the public, which includes a likelihood of association with the earlier trade mark.
- Registration of International Registration No. 1033667 designating the United Kingdom would therefore be contrary to Section 5(2)(b) of the UK Trade Marks Act 1994.
- 14. The mark subject of International Registration No. 1033667 designating the United Kingdom also covers goods which may not be considered similar to the goods covered by the opponent's earlier trade mark. The earlier trade mark of the opponent enjoys a reputation in the United Kingdom, and use of the mark subject of International Registration No. 1033667 designating the United Kingdom would, without due cause, take unfair advantage of, and/or be detrimental to, the distinctive character, and/or repute, of the opponent's earlier trade mark.
- Registration of International Registration No. 1033867 designating the United Kingdom would therefore be contrary to Section 5(3) of the UK Trade Marks Act 1994.
- 16. The opponent requests that International Registration No. 1033687 designating the United Kingdom be refused in its entirety.
- 17. The opponent requests an award of costs in its favour.

Costs proceedings before the comptroller

Preparing a statement and considering the other side's statement From £200 to £600 depending on the nature of the statements, for example their complexity and relevance.

Preparing evidence and considering and commenting on the other side's evidence From £500 if the evidence is light or £2000 if the evidence is substantial. The award could go above this range in exceptionally large cases but will be cut down if the successful party had filed a significant amount of unnecessary evidence.

Preparing for and attending a hearing

Up to £1500 per day of hearing, capped at £3000 for the full hearing unless one side has behaved unreasonably. From £300 to £500 for preparation of submissions, depending on their substance, if there is no oral hearing.
