This is a **PROVISIONAL FULL REFUSAL** of the request for extension of protection of the mark in the above-referenced U.S. application. *See* 15 U.S.C. §1141h(c). See below in this notification (hereafter "Office action") for details regarding the provisional full refusal.

Search Results

The referenced application has been reviewed by the assigned trademark examining attorney. Applicant must respond timely and completely to the issue(s) below. 15 U.S.C. §1062(b); 37 C.F.R. §§2.62, 2.65(a); TMEP §§711, 718.03.

The Office records have been searched and there are no similar registered or pending marks that would bar registration under Trademark Act Section 2(d), 15 U.S.C. §1052(d). TMEP §704.02.

However, in order to pursue registration, applicant must respond to the following.

Name and National Citizenship of the Sole Proprietor Required

Applicant is identified in the application as a sole proprietorship named "Gorokhovskaya Tatyana Germanovna", organized in Russia. In addition to the applicant name and country of organization provided, however, applicant must also specify the name and national citizenship of the individual person who is the sole proprietor. TMEP §803.03(a).

The following format for identifying a sole proprietorship should be used: "Gorokhovskaya Tatyana Germanovna", a Russian sole proprietorship, composed of *{specify name of individual and country of citizenship}*" TMEP §803.03(a). The name of the sole proprietorship and the name of the individual can be the same

TMEP §§803.02(a), 803.04.

Color Mark Clarification Required

In the description of the mark, the applicant references light black and white; however, the applicant has not indicated black and white as features of the mark. If applicant references color in the description of the mark, applicant must claim those colors as a feature of the mark. TMEP §807.07(d); see 37 C.F.R. §§2.37, 2.52(b)(1).

If black, white and/or gray are not being claimed as a color feature of the mark, applicant must state that the colors black, white and/or gray represent background, outlining, shading and/or transparent areas and are not part of the mark. TMEP §807.07(d).

In this case, applicant may indicate that the mark is not in color and delete references to color in the mark, or, in the alternative, claim the colors black and white as features of the mark and reference those colors in the description of the mark.

In addition, applicant must submit an accurate and concise description of the literal and design elements in the mark. 37 C.F.R. §2.37; see TMEP §§808.01, 808.02. The following is suggested, if accurate:

Color Claim: the colors black and white are claimed as a feature of the mark.

<u>Description:</u> The mark consists of a large fruit-bearing apple tree within a rectangular background with rounded corners. The color white appears in the background and the color black appears in the silhouette of the shape of the tree and apples.

OR

The mark consists of a large fruit-bearing apple tree within a rectangular background with rounded corners.

Clarification of the Identification of Goods and Services Required

Some of the wording in the identification of goods and/or services must be clarified because it is indefinite. *See* TMEP §§1402.01, 1402.03. For example, the wording "dietetic substances adapted for medical use" requires clarification because it fails to indicate specific goods.

The international classification of goods and/or services in applications filed under Trademark Act Section 66(a) cannot be changed from the classification the International Bureau assigned to the goods and/or services in the corresponding international registration. TMEP §§1401.03(d), 1904.02(b).

Therefore, any modification to this wording must identify goods and/or services in International Classes 003, 005, 016, 021, 025, 029, 030, 035, and 041, the classifications specified in the application for these goods and/or services.

The following suggested identification contains further guidance in bold and/or brackets. Applicant may adopt any or all of the suggestions so long as they are accurate. If applicant does not adopt a suggestion, then applicant must amend the identification so that it is as specific as the suggestions and language found in the *Manual of Acceptable Identifications of Goods and Services*

Applicant may consider the following suggestions:
