5. Ground(s) of the Provisional Refusal:

Specification of goods and/or services

- 5.1. We note that you have applied for protection of the mark for goods and services in various classes. However, we have raised objections under rule 19(2)(b)(ii)(A) of the Trade Marks Rules as the following goods and services do not follow the guidelines provided under the International Classification of Goods and Services (ICGS):

(a) Class 03

- (i) "care agents, light metal or metal alloy wheel rim care agents" in the description "cleaning, care, preservation, polishing, scouring and abrasive agents, in particular such for vehicles, engines/motors and machines (including drive units and construction machines), including detergents, windscreen/windshield washer fluids, wax compositions, cleaning sprays, auto shampoos, spray preservatives, interior



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cleaning agents, motor cleaning agents, light metal or metal alloy wheel rim care agents” – The description is vague and can refer to items included in other classes. Please clarify on the exact nature of the intended items;

- (ii) “perfume atomisers, powder boxes” in the description “perfumery, essential oils, cosmetics, hair lotions, including perfume atomisers, toilet waters, non-medicated toilet preparations, powder boxes, shaving and after-shave preparations, oils, creams and lotions for the skin” – The description “perfume atomisers” is listed in Class 21 and “powder boxes” appears to be analogous to “powder compacts” which is classified in Class 21. Please consider amending the objected description to “perfume in perfume atomisers, powder in powder boxes”, if intended.

(b) Class 05

- (i) “desinfectants” – There appears to be a spelling error in the word. Please consider amending the word to “disinfectant”, if intended.

(c) Class 06

- (i) “tank accessories, key ring pendants, luggage labels of metal” in the description “ironmongery, small items of metal hardware and goods of common metal (included in this class), including locks, latches, metallic tubes, metallic hoses, metallic valves for pipes, pipes, pipe connections, screws, bolts, nuts, rivets, lock washers, spring washers, flat washers, chains (except drive chains for vehicles), plugs, split pins, shims, spacer rings, and clips, woodruff keys, screw unions, spring bolts, shackles, ball joints, hinges, brackets, tanks for liquids, tank accessories, nipples, fuel cans, ladders, handles, metallic signs, wire baskets, metal wires, badges for vehicles, fasteners, tow ropes of metal, canisters, badges, keys, key blanks, key ring pendants and pins, vehicle registration plates, non-luminous signs, boxes, luggage labels of metal, ornaments, safes, ores” – The description is vague and can refer to items included in other classes. The description “key ring pendants” can refer to “pendants” which is classified in Class 14, “luggage labels of metal” can refer to “luggage tags” and “luggage tags of metal” which are classified in Class 18. As such, please consider removing “key ring pendants” and “luggage labels of metal” from this class and clarify on the exact nature of “tank accessories”.

(d) Class 07

- (i) “ignition systems, spark plug connectors, lambda probes” in the description “carburettors, converters for liquid fuels, injectors, injection pumps, fuel pumps, speed governors, injection nozzles and nozzle holders, machine valves, vaporizers, starters, ignition systems, ignition coils, glow plugs, spark plugs, spark plug connectors, lambda probes, magnetos, silencers/mufflers and spark arresters for combustion engines” – The description is vague and can refer to items included in other classes. For example, “ignition systems” can refer to “ignition systems, electric, for igniting at a distance” which is classified in Class 09, “spark plug connectors” can refer to “plug-in connectors of metal” which is classified in Class 06 and “plug connectors (electric)” which is classified in Class 09 and “lambda probes” can refer to “oxygen sensors, other than for medical use” which is classified in Class 09 and “oxygen sensors for medical use” based on our search on the internet. As such, please consider



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amending “ignition systems” to “ignition devices for engines”, if intended and remove the remaining objected items from this class;

(ii) “air pumps as vehicle accessories” in the description “hydraulic pumps and motors and components thereof, air pumps as vehicle accessories” – The description is vague and appears to be analogous to “air pumps [vehicle accessories]” which is classified in Class 12. Please consider removing the objected item from this class;

(iii) “power steering systems” in the description “power steering systems, control valves (machine parts), braking valves (machine parts)” – The description is vague and can refer to items included in other classes. For example, “automatic steering apparatus” and “simulators for the steering and control of vehicles” are classified in Class 09. Please clarify on the intended nature of the goods;

(iv) “electronic control devices for production technology and servo drives” – The description is vague and can refer to items included in other classes. For example, the description “electronic control apparatus” is classified in Class 09. Please clarify on the exact nature of the goods intended;

(v) “dump bodies” in the description “loaders, dumper bodies, excavators as well as parts, including components, and accessories to such products” – The description is vague and can refer to items included in other classes. The description can refer to “body parts for vehicles” which is classified in Class 12. Please consider removing the objected description from this class;

(vi) “car wash facility” – The description is vague. For clarity purposes, please consider amending the description to “car wash installations”, if intended;

(vii) “parts, fittings and accessories for motor land vehicles” in the description “parts, fittings and accessories for the abovementioned goods and for motor land vehicles” – The description is vague and can refer to items included in other classes. For example, “body parts for vehicles”, “interior fittings (trim) for vehicles” which are classified in Class 12. Please consider removing the objected description from this class.

(e) Class 09

(i) “electric blowers” in the description “programmable controllers electric and electronic apparatus and instruments, including electric batteries, charging devices, battery testers, electric mountings, electric blowers” – The description is vague and can refer to items included in other classes. For example, “blowers (machines)” is classified in Class 07 and “electrically powered blowers for ventilation” is classified in Class 11. Please clarify on the intended nature of the goods;

(ii) “storage boxes for recording media” – The description is vague and can refer to items included in other classes. For example, the description can refer to “boxes for storage purposes (metal)” which is classified in Class 06, “boxes for storage purposes (card)” which is classified in Class 16, “boxes for storage purposes (vulcanised fibre)” which is classified in Class 17 and “boxes for storage purposes (plastic or wood)” which is classified in Class 20. Please consider removing the description from this class;



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(iii) “machines (including drive units and construction machines)” in the description “dynamometers, brake testers, electrical and mechanical instruments and apparatus for control and testing for vehicles, engines/motors and machines (including drive units and construction machines)” – The description is vague and can refer to items included in other classes. For example, “machines” and “construction machines” are classified in Class 07. Please clarify on the exact nature of the intended goods;

(iv) “vehicle immobilizing units” in the description “automatic alarm units, anti-theft warning devices, electronic anti-theft devices, including vehicle immobilizing units” – The description is vague and can refer to items included in other classes. Based on our searches on the internet, we note that the description appears to be referring to “electronic security devices for vehicles” which is classified in Class 12. Please consider removing the objected description from this class.

(f) Class 11

(i) “parts and fittings for vehicles, engines/motors and machines (including drive units and construction machines)” – The description is vague and can include items classified in other classes. Please specify the exact items that you are claiming for.

(g) Class 12

(i) “vehicles, including cars, vans, sport-utility vehicles (including golf carts), buses, trucks, tractor units/prime movers, on and off road vehicles/dump trucks and parts, including components, and accessories to these items which do not pertain to other classes, including vehicle chassis, vehicle bodies, braking installations, brake calipers, draw bars, bumper bars, clutches, engines, electric engines, motors, electric motors, turbines, combustion engines, starting devices for internal combustion engines, hydraulic cylinders and motors, silencers/mufflers, spark eliminators, power transmissions, gearboxes/transmissions, transmission shafts, differential gears, drive gears, drive shafts, gear change selectors, exhaust cowls, axles, shafts and couplings, machine coupling and transmission components, manual and power steering apparatus, power steering systems, hydraulic steering systems, as well as component parts of these items, compressed air reservoirs, compressed air cylinders and anti-pollution devices, air pumps, anti-dazzle devices, anti-theft devices and alarms, vehicle immobilizing units, trailer hitches, power take-offs, springs, shock absorbers, wheels, wheel bearings, wheel trims, balance weights for wheels, engine mountings, tanks and fuel tanks, engine noise shields, protective covers, radiators grilles, front grills, fluid reservoirs, deflectors, direction indicators, hatches, upholstery, handles for doors, hoods, horns, hubs, hub caps, hydraulic circuits, tyres, non-skid devices for tyres, mud flaps, brakes, servo brakes and compressed-air brakes, antilock brake systems, brake pads and brake linings, bumpers, mudguards/fenders, cabs, cab tilt mechanisms, reversing alarms, mechanical controls, head rests for seats, arm rests, doors, seats, safety-seats, personal safety restraints seats, safety seats for children, tables for seats, seat covers, headrest covers, seat belts, devices for collision protection, parking assistance systems, sliding roofs, sun roofs, vehicle steering columns, steering wheels, steering linkages, stabiliser bars, suspensions, suspension lowering outfits, torsion bars, tow bars, windows, window winding mechanisms, power windows, windscreens/windshields (also of safety glass), windscreen/windshield and headlight wipers, defrosting systems for windscreens, wiper blades, vehicle window blinds, driving mirrors, mirrors (retrovisors), tank caps,



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cover caps for extra headlights, warning lamps, luggage restraints for vehicles, luggage nets, luggage carriers, wheel carriers, bicycle carriers, surfboard carriers, boat carriers, mud-guards, snow chains, pet screens, stone screens, storage screens, roof racks and ski racks, stowage boxes, deposit boxes, stowage compartments, trim panels, spoilers, side and rear skirts, safety cushions, air bags, breakdown cases, holders for mirrors, sun shades, mobile telephone mounting equipment”:

- (A) “silencers/mufflers” and “engine noise shields” – The description is vague and can refer to items included in other classes. For example, “silencers as part of vehicle exhaust systems” and “sound absorbers (silencers) being parts of vehicle exhaust systems” are classified in Class 07. As such, please consider removing the description from this class;
- (B) “machine coupling and transmission components” – The description is vague and can refer to items included in other classes. For example, “couplings for machines” and transmissions for machines” are classified in Class 07. Please consider amending the description to “land vehicle coupling and transmission components”, if intended;
- (C) “anti-pollution devices” – The description is vague and can refer to items included in other classes. For example, “anti-pollution devices for motors and engines” is classified in Class 07. As such, please consider removing the description from this class;
- (D) “devices for collision protection” – The description is vague and can refer to items included in other classes. For clarity purposes, please consider amending the description to “devices specially adapted for use with vehicles for collision protection”, if intended;
- (E) “parking assistance systems” – The description is vague and can refer to items included in other classes. For example, “electronic apparatus for the control of car parking” is classified in Class 09. Please clarify on the nature of the goods to help us classify it;
- (F) “suspension lowering outfits” – The description is vague. Please clarify on the exact nature of the goods to help us classify it;
- (G) “defrosting systems for windscreen” – The description is vague and can refer to items included in other classes. For example, “defrosting apparatus for vehicles” is classified in Class 11. As such, please consider removing this description from the class;
- (H) “breakdown cases” – The description is vague. Please clarify on the exact nature of the item to help us classify it;
- (I) “mobile telephone mounting equipment” – The description is vague and can refer to items included in other classes. For clarity purposes, please consider amending the description to “mobile telephone mounting equipment specially adapted for vehicles”, if intended.

(h) Class 17



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- (i) “felt rings” in the description “rubber supports for motors/engines, reflex tape, felt rings, sealing compound, non-metallic tubes, pipe connection parts for radiator systems, radiator sealing compounds, fasteners and connectors, all made of plastic materials, for pipes and cables” – The description is vague. Please clarify on the exact nature of the intended goods to help us classify it;
 - (ii) “washers (other than washers for water taps) made of plastics materials” in the description “washers (other than washers for water taps) made of rubber, plastics materials or of vulcanised fibre” – The description is vague and can refer to items included in other classes. For example, “spring washers of plastic” is classified in Class 20. Please consider removing the objected description from this class;
 - (iii) “grommets made of plastics material” in the description “grommets made of rubber or of plastics material” – The exact description is listed in Class 20 and not in Class 17. Please consider removing the description from this class;
 - (iv) “locking compounds and fluids” in the description “packing and stopping materials, including oil seals (packing), sealing, locking and caulking compounds and fluids (in the nature of jointings or packings)” – The description is vague and can refer to items included in other classes. Please clarify on the exact nature of the items to help us classify it;
 - (v) “parts and fittings for vehicles, engines/motors and machines (including drive units and construction machines)” – The description is vague and can refer to items included in other classes. Please consider removing the description from this class.
- (i) Class 20
- (i) “canisters” in the description “storage containers, storage boxes for recording media (included in class 20), boxes, canisters” – The description is vague and can refer to items included in other classes. For example, “metal butane fuel canisters sold empty” is classified in Class 06 and “canister sets” is classified in Class 21. Please clarify on the exact nature of the item or consider removing it from this class;
- (j) Class 21
- (i) “car wash leather” in the description “articles for cleaning purposes, including cleaning utensils for vehicles, in particular sponges, car wash leather, cleaning cloths and hand operated cleaning devices” – The description is vague. Please clarify on the exact nature of the intended goods.
- (k) Class 22
- (i) “spare wheel cover” in the description “ropes, towropes, string, spare wheel cover, nets, tents, awning, tarpaulins, sails, sacks and bags for packaging, storage and transport” – The exact description is listed in Class 12. Please consider removing the description from this class.
- (l) Class 24
- (i) “(roller) blinds” – The description is vague and can refer to items included in other classes. For example, “roller blinds of steel” is classified in Class 06, “roller blinds for



external use (not of metal or textile)” is classified in Class 19, “roller blinds (indoor)” is classified in Class 20 and “roller blinds of textile for external use” is classified in Class 22. Please consider amending the description to “textile materials for use in the manufacture of (roller) blinds”, if intended or consider removing the description from this class.

(m) Class 35

- (i) “consultancy in the field of vehicle fleet management” – The description is vague and can refer to services included in other classes. For clarity purposes, please consider amending the description to “business consultancy in the field of vehicle fleet management”, if intended.

(n) Class 37

- (i) “inspection services” in the description “installation, service, repair, inspection, restoration, maintenance, reconditioning, diagnostic tuning, cleaning, painting, polishing and preservation services in relation to vehicles, engines/motors and machines (including drive units and construction, agricultural and forestry machines), power hand tools, workshop appliances and devices, or parts, fittings and accessories (including telecommunication equipment) for the aforesaid” – The description is vague and can refer to services included in other classes. For example, “inspection of vessels” and “inspection of goods for transportation” are classified in Class 39 and “technical inspection services” is classified in Class 42. Please consider removing the objected item from this class;
- (ii) “rental of tools and workshop equipment” – The description is vague and can include services included in other classes. For clarity purposes, please consider amending the description to “rental of tools and workshop equipment for installation, repair and maintenance purposes”, if intended;
- (iii) “looking after of motor vehicles in motor-sport events” in the description “looking after and overhauling of motor vehicles in motor-sport events” – The description is vague. Please clarify on the exact nature of the intended services to help us classify it;
- (iv) “reservation of garage services for the maintenance and repair of motor vehicles” – The description is vague and can refer to services included in other classes. For example, “rental of garage space” is classified in Class 39. For clarity purposes, please consider amending the description to “garage services for the maintenance and repair of motor vehicles”, if intended;
- (v) “technical assistance related to motor vehicles during motorsports events” – The description is vague. According to our Circular No. 25/2006 of 16 August 2006 (<http://goo.gl/LdFF8L>), “technical consultancy services” is classified based on its subject matter. As such, please consider amending the description to “technical assistance related to repair and maintenance of motor vehicles during motorsports events”, if intended.

(o) Class 39

- (i) “rental of machines (including drive units and construction and transport machines)” in the description “rental of vehicles, engines/motors and machines (including drive



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units and construction and transport machines)” – The description is vague and can refer to services included in other classes. “Rental of machines” is classified based on the purpose of the machines. As such, “rental of construction machines” is classified in Class 37. For clarity purposes, please consider amending the objected description to “rental of machines, namely drive units (for transport purpose) and transport machines”, if intended;

(ii) “including mobile telematics applications” in the description “consultation in the field of traffic and transport, including mobile telematics applications” – The description is vague. Please consider amending the entire description to “providing consultation in the field of traffic and transport via mobile telematics applications”, if intended;

(iii) “logistic services” – The description is vague and can refer to services included in other classes. Please consider amending the description to “logistics services consisting of transport, packaging and storage of goods”, if intended.

(p) Class 41

(i) “camp services for sport activities: museum services” – It appears that the colon “:” appearing between the two items should be a semi-colon “;”. Please confirm if we may amend it to be a semi-colon.

(q) Class 42

(i) “technical consultation” in the description “technical consultation and preparation of expert opinions” – The description is vague and can refer to services included in other classes. According to our Circular No. 25/2006 of 16 August 2006 (<http://goo.gl/LdFF8L>), “technical consultancy services” per se is vague for classification and will be classified based on its subject matter. As such, please consider amending the whole description to “preparation of expert opinions (technical report) and technical consultancy relating thereto”, if intended;

(ii) “design and development of IT services, services” in the description “design and development of computer hardware and software, IT services via data processing centers, service and alarm centers for transport and traffic, in particular the detection, checking (supervision), evaluation and processing of alarm messages, and signal, measuring, sound, image, video, position, movement, state and working hour data and (remote) control/automatic control of land vehicles, air vehicles and aircraft, locomotion systems, the load/cargo thereof as well as between engines/motors and machines (including drive units and construction machines)” – The description is vague and can refer to services included in other classes. Please clarify on the exact nature of the intended services;

(iii) “technical consultation in the field of recycling” – The description is vague and can refer to services included in other classes. According to our Circular No. 25/2006 of 16 August 2006 (<http://goo.gl/LdFF8L>), “technical consultancy services” per se is vague for classification and will be classified based on its subject matter. “Recycling” per se is classified in Class 40. As such, “technical consultation in the field of recycling” will be classified in Class 40. For clarity purposes, please consider amending the description to “technological consultation in the field of recycling”, if intended.



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- 5.2. Please note that no form or fee is required for an amendment to the specification of goods or services of an international registration designating Singapore.

6. Goods and/or services affected by the refusal:

This refusal applies to “care agents, light metal or metal alloy wheel rim care agents” in the description “cleaning, care, preservation, polishing, scouring and abrasive agents, in particular such for vehicles, engines/motors and machines (including drive units and construction machines), including detergents, windscreen/windshield washer fluids, wax compositions, cleaning sprays, auto shampoos, spray preservatives, interior cleaning agents, motor cleaning agents, light metal or metal alloy wheel rim care agents” and “perfume atomisers, powder boxes” in the description “perfumery, essential oils, cosmetics, hair lotions, including perfume atomisers, toilet waters, non-medicated toilet preparations, powder boxes, shaving and after-shave preparations, oils, creams and lotions for the skin” in Class 03, “desinfectants” in Class 05, “tank accessories, key ring pendants, luggage labels of metal” in the description “ironmongery, small items of metal hardware and goods of common metal (included in this class), including locks, latches, metallic tubes, metallic hoses, metallic valves for pipes, pipes, pipe connections, screws, bolts, nuts, rivets, lock washers, spring washers, flat washers, chains (except drive chains for vehicles), plugs, split pins, shims, spacer rings, and clips, woodruff keys, screw unions, spring bolts, shackles, ball joints, hinges, brackets, tanks for liquids, tank accessories, nipples, fuel cans, ladders, handles, metallic signs, wire baskets, metal wires, badges for vehicles, fasteners, tow ropes of metal, canisters, badges, keys, key blanks, key ring pendants and pins, vehicle registration plates, non-luminous signs, boxes, luggage labels of metal, ornaments, safes, ores” in Class 06, “ignition systems, spark plug connectors, lambda probes” in the description “carburettors, converters for liquid fuels, injectors, injection pumps, fuel pumps, speed governors, injection nozzles and nozzle holders, machine valves, vaporizers, starters, ignition systems, ignition coils, glow plugs, spark plugs, spark plug connectors, lambda probes, magnetos, silencers/mufflers and spark arresters for combustion engines”, “air pumps as vehicle accessories” in the description “hydraulic pumps and motors and components thereof, air pumps as vehicle accessories”, “power steering systems” in the description “power steering systems, control valves (machine parts), braking valves (machine parts)”, “electronic control devices for production technology and servo drives”, “dump bodies” in the description “loaders, dumper bodies, excavators as well as parts, including components, and accessories to such products”, “car wash facility” and “parts, fittings and accessories for motor land vehicles” in the description “parts, fittings and accessories for the abovementioned goods and for motor land vehicles” in Class 07, “electric blowers” in the description “programmable controllers electric and electronic apparatus and instruments, including electric batteries, charging devices, battery testers, electric mountings, electric blowers”, “storage boxes for recording media”, “machines (including drive units and construction machines)” in the description “dynamometers, brake testers, electrical and mechanical instruments and apparatus for control and testing for vehicles, engines/motors and machines (including drive units and construction machines)” and “vehicle immobilizing units” in the description “automatic alarm units, anti-theft warning devices, electronic anti-theft devices, including vehicle immobilizing units” in Class 09, “parts and fittings for vehicles, engines/motors and machines (including drive units and construction machines)” in Class 11, “silencers/mufflers” and “engine noise shields”, “machine coupling and transmission components”, “anti-pollution devices”, “devices for collision protection”, “parking assistance systems”, “suspension lowering outfits”, “defrosting systems for windscreen”, “breakdown cases” and “mobile telephone mounting equipment” in Class 12, “felt rings” in the description “rubber supports for motors/engines, reflex tape, felt rings, sealing compound, non-metallic



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tubes, pipe connection parts for radiator systems, radiator sealing compounds, fasteners and connectors, all made of plastic materials, for pipes and cables”, “washers (other than washers for water taps made of plastics materials)” in the description “washers (other than washers for water taps) made of rubber, plastics materials or of vulcanised fibre”, “grommets made of plastics material” in the description “grommets made of rubber or of plastics material”, “locking compounds and fluids” in the description “packing and stopping materials, including oil seals (packing), sealing, locking and caulking compounds and fluids (in the nature of jointings or packings)” and “parts and fittings for vehicles, engines/motors and machines (including drive units and construction machines)” in Class 17, “canisters” in the description “storage containers, storage boxes for recording media (included in class 20), boxes, canisters” in Class 20, “car wash leather” in the description “articles for cleaning purposes, including cleaning utensils for vehicles, in particular sponges, car wash leather, cleaning cloths and hand operated cleaning devices” in Class 21, “spare wheel cover” in the description “ropes, towropes, string, spare wheel cover, nets, tents, awning, tarpaulins, sails, sacks and bags for packaging, storage and transport” in Class 22, “(roller) blinds” in Class 24, “consultancy in the field of vehicle fleet management” in Class 35, “inspection services” in the description “installation, service, repair, inspection, restoration, maintenance, reconditioning, diagnostic tuning, cleaning, painting, polishing and preservation services in relation to vehicles, engines/motors and machines (including drive units and construction, agricultural and forestry machines), power hand tools, workshop appliances and devices, or parts, fittings and accessories (including telecommunication equipment) for the aforesaid”, “rental of tools and workshop equipment”, “looking after of motor vehicles in motor-sport events” in the description “looking after and overhauling of motor vehicles in motor-sport events”, “reservation of garage services for the maintenance and repair of motor vehicles” and “technical assistance related to motor vehicles during motorsports events” in Class 37, “rental of machines (including drive units and construction and transport machines)” in the description “rental of vehicles, engines/motors and machines (including drive units and construction and transport machines)”, “including mobile telematics applications” in the description “consultation in the field of traffic and transport, including mobile telematics applications” and “logistic services” in Class 39, “camp services for sport activities: museum services” in Class 41 and “technical consultation” in the description “technical consultation and preparation of expert opinions”, “design and development of IT services, services” in the description “design and development of computer hardware and software, IT services via data processing centers, service and alarm centers for transport and traffic, in particular the detection, checking (supervision), evaluation and processing of alarm messages, and signal, measuring, sound, image, video, position, movement, state and working hour data and (remote) control/automatic control of land vehicles, air vehicles and aircraft, locomotion systems, the load/cargo thereof as well as between engines/motors and machines (including drive units and construction machines)” and “technical consultation in the field of recycling” in Class 42 of the international registration.

7. Request for review:

The holder of the international registration may file a request for a review of this refusal with IPOS.

The request for review must comply with the following:

- (a) quote the International Registration number, relevant trade mark number(s), corresponding class number(s) and Singapore reference number(s).
- (b) furnish an address for service in Singapore. The holder may appoint an agent by filing Form CM1.



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Please note that any form(s) filed with the International Bureau of the World Intellectual Property Organization in response to this refusal, will not be treated as a request for a review of this refusal unless the above has been complied with.

8. Extension of time:

The holder may seek an extension of time to request for a review of this refusal by filing Form CM5.

9. Deadline to observe:

If the holder does not file a request for review or apply for an extension of time to do so by **23 June 2016**, the application for the refused goods and/or services indicated in paragraph 6 of this refusal will be treated as withdrawn (reinstatable).

10. Reinstatement of an application that is treated as withdrawn (reinstatable):

If the application becomes treated as withdrawn (reinstatable), the holder may request to reinstate the application by filing Form CM13 together with the request for review within six months from the deadline in paragraph 9.

Please note that reinstatement is not automatic. Reinstatement will be allowed only after we have conducted a new conflicting mark search and are satisfied that the mark to be reinstated does not conflict with any trade mark applications filed with IPOS prior to the filing of the required documents.

If the holder also does not request to reinstate the application in time, the application for goods and/or services that are not refused will proceed to publication.

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PROVISIONS OF SINGAPORE LAW

TRADE MARKS RULES

Rule 19 Specification

(2) Every application form shall contain, for each class of goods or services to which the application relates

(a) the class number as set out in the Nice Classification as in force on the date of that application; and

(b) a specification of those goods or services which

(i) is appropriate to that class;

(ii) is described in such a manner as to

(A) indicate clearly the nature of those goods or services; and

(B) allow those goods or services to be classified in accordance with the Nice Classification as in force on the date of that application; and

(iii) complies with any other requirement of the Registrar.



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
